TERPS OPEN SPRING PRACTICE: The Maryland football team, coming off a 9-4 season, including its school-record third-straight bowl victory, kicks off spring practice on Tuesday, March 27 when the Terps hit the field for the first of 15 workouts. The team, which returns 41 letterwinners, including 13 offensive and defensive starters, will practice each Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday for five weeks, with workouts ending with the annual Spring Game on Saturday, April 28 (3:30 p.m.). Normal practice time will be 4 p.m. each Tuesday and Thursday and 10 a.m. Saturday (see adjacent schedule). Practices are open to the media.

SPRING GAME SET FOR SATURDAY, APRIL 28: The University of Maryland football team will close its 2007 spring campaign on Saturday, April 28 with the annual Red/White game at Chevy Chase Bank Field at Byrd Stadium. The contest is scheduled to kickoff at 3:30 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast by Johnny Holliday (play-by-play) and Jonathan Claiborne (color) on the Terrapin Sports Radio Network.

FRIEDGEN ENTERS SECOND SEASON AS OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR: For the second straight season, head coach **Ralph Friedgen** will double as the offensive coordinator. Friedgen had given thought to stepping aside at the end of last season, but decided to assume the role again due in part to the continuity with the offensive staff. There were no offensive staff changes. In addition, **John Donovan** enters his second season as the quarterbacks coach and **Phil Zacharias** is in year two as the running backs coach.

LEMPA ADDED TO COACHING STAFF: Each season brings changes to a collegiate football staff, but the Terps remained fairly stable with just one off-season adjustment as **Kevin Lempa** replaced Tim Banks in January as the secondary coach. Banks, who was on the staff for four seasons, took the defensive coordinator position at Central Michigan University. Lempa is a former collegiate defensive coordinator with NFL experience. Lempa spent the last four seasons as the secondary coach with Boston College, where he led one of the top units in the ACC. The Eagles were among the nation's best in picking off passes last season. Their 21 interceptions were tied for third nationally, trailing only Western Michigan (24) and Wake Forest (22). They also had 17 interceptions in 2004 which led the Big East Conference. Two of Lempa's defensive backs - cornerback DeJuan Tribble and strong safety Ryan Glasper - were All-ACC performers last season.

SEVEN STARTERS RETURN ON OFFENSE: The Terps return seven starters on offense, including running back Lance Ball, wide receiver Darrius Heyward-Bey, tight end Joey Haynos and three linemen (see chart on page 3). In fact, backs who accounted for 94 percent of the rushing yards have returned, as well as pass-catchers who accounted for 97 percent of the receiving yards. The problem is the Terps have to replace the triggerman, as two-year starting quarterback Sam Hollenbach departed, as did All-ACC left tackle Stephon Heyer. Heyer was the leader on the offensive line which opened holes for the Ball and running mate Keon Lattimore and allowed Hollenbach to toss for over 2,300 yards en route to All-ACC honors. Junior **Jordan Steffy** enters the spring as the starter after two seasons as a backup. He has seen limited action in his career, but has been in Friedgen's offensive system for three years. This will mark the fifth time in the last seven years the Terps will break in a new starting guarterback. An offensive line that surrendered the second-fewest sacks in the ACC last season will have to be re-tooled. Senior guard Andrew Crummey, an All-ACC performer, junior center Edwin Williams and junior tackle Jared Gaither are the returning starters, though Gaither will sit out this spring.

2007 University of Maryland Football: Spring Notes (March 27)

DEFENSE RETURNS SIX STARTERS: The Terrapin defense returns six starters from a year ago (see chart on page 3), though that unit lost three of its top four tacklers. However, there were a number of part-time players from a year ago who should step into starting roles this season. Junior Erin Henderson, the team's leading tackler and an All-ACC performer last season, headlines not only the linebacking corps, but the whole defense. Conrad Bolston has departed from the defensive line, but pass rusher Jeremy Navarre and run-stopper Dre Moore return. Carlos Feliciano, who started seven games last season, will step into Bolston's tackle spot where the Terps hope to have an improved rushing defense. With the departure of Wesley Jefferson and David Holloway. the linebacking corps will have to be a focus this spring. Younger, more inexperienced players will likely man those spots, while Trey Covington is back as the starter at LEO, a hybrid defensive end/linebacker position. There will be personnel and position changes in the secondary where All-American cornerback Josh Wilson and strong safety Marcus Wimbush have departed. Senior Isaiah Gardner returns at cornerback and Christian Varner will move from free safety to strong safety this spring.

NEW SPECIALISTS ON TAP: Chief among the concerns of the coaching staff is the lack of a punter or place-kicker. All-ACC performers Adam Podlesh and Dan Ennis have completed their eligibility and will have to be replaced. No one on the roster has punted or place-kicked during a collegiate game. Junior Chris Roberts and true freshman Travis Baltz, who entered school early this semester, will battle it out for the punting job. After serving as one of the kickoff specialists the last two seasons, junior Obi **Egekeze** is likely to handle the place-kicking chores. He has never attempted a kick in a game. Junior Danny Oquendo is back as the No. 1 punt returner. He ranked eighth in the ACC in returns last season, averaging 8.4 yards per attempt. With the departure of Josh Wilson, who ranked 11th in the nation with 27.3 yard average, the Terps are in search of a No. 1 kickoff return specialist. Redshirt freshman Da'Rel Scott enters the spring No. 1 on the depth chart, but a number of individuals will get a shot, including Emen Ifon, Terrell Skinner and Anthony Wiseman.

OUT FOR THE SPRING: Four Terps will not participate in spring due to injury. That group includes junior WR Isaiah Williams (shoulder surgery), senior CB Isaiah Gardner (shoulder surgery), senior DL Jermaine Lemons (knee) and junior LB Rick Costa (shoulder surgery). All are expected back for fall workouts.

POSITION CHANGES: The Terps will make some position changes this spring. Christian Varner, the starting free safety last season, has moved to strong safety, while reserve linebacker Steven Pfister has transferred to the offense, now serving as the backup to fullback Cory Jackson. A number of linebackers are likely to shuffle around this spring as defensive coordinator looks to find two new starters with the departure of Mike LB Wesley Jefferson and Sam LB David Holloway.

TERPS SHINE AT PRO TIMING Representatives from approximately 25 NFL teams were on campus Wednesday, March 14 to evaluate 12 former University of Maryland football players at the team's annual Pro Timing Day. The former players who hope to become the next Terps to play in the NFL, include RB Josh Allen, DL Conrad Bolston. RB T.D. Callahan. PK Dan Ennis. OL Stephon Hever, RB J.P. Humber, QB Sam Hollenbach. LB David Holloway, WR Danny Melendez, PAdam Podlesh, CB Josh Wilson and DB Marcus Wimbush. All but Melendez completed their eligibility last fall. Holloway, who played in the Hula Bowl in January and was Maryland's third-leading tackler (70) last season, had 32 repetitions on the 225-pound bench press, while Heyer and Bolston each had 30. Melendez, who completed his eligibility in 2005, had the highest vertical jump, reaching 40 inches. Wimbush, the Terps' fourthleading tackler in 2006, was just off the pace at 39.5 inches, while Holloway cleared 37 inches. Melendez produced the top time in the all-important 40-yard dash, clocking a 4.39, Allen, who missed all of 2005 with a serious knee injury, posted a solid 4.57 and Wimbush went the distance in 4.62 seconds. Wilson, a 2006 honorable mention All-American, took part in only one event after spending a number of days at the NFL Combine in Indianapolis, Ind., under scrutiny by the pro teams. Wilson, who posted a time of 4.23 seconds in the pro shuttle drill, was one of three Terps at Februarys NFL Combine as he was joined by Podlesh and Heyer. Wilson ran a 4.39 in the 40 and had 20 reps in the bench press at the NFL Combine. Heyer and Podlesh also were selected to work out

2007 RECRUITING CLASS

The Maryland football team signed 25 student-athletes to national letters of intent in February for the 2007 season.

The class is highlighted by four All-Americans, 15 student-athletes ranked among the top 100 nationally at their positions, and 18 who received all-state honors during their careers.

TE **Devonte Campbell**, WR **Tony Logan**, RB **Ronnie Tyler** and TE **Lansford Watson** were each SuperPrep All-Americans. Watson was also a PrepStar All-American. In addition, all four were named all-state.

DL Dion Armstrong, P Travis Baltz, OL Tyler Bowen, DL Ian Davidson, WR Derek Drummond, OL Joe Faiella, DL Maurice Hampton, DB Dominique Herald, OL Bearthur Johnson, WR Quinton McCree, LB Ben Pooler, WR, Torrey Smith, OL Joe Vellano and RB Taylor Watson were each all-state honorees.

Of the 15 signees ranking in the top 100 at their positions by various entities, six were ranked among the top 25.

Bruce Campbell is rated as the No. 17 offensive tackle prospect by Scouts, Inc. and Devonte Campbell is 12th among tight ends by Scouts, Inc. Hampton checked in as the No. 25 offensive guard by Scouts, Inc.

In addition, Herald was the No. 6 safety by Scouts, Inc. and Logan the No. 10 defensive back by SuperPrep. Lansford Watson was also the No. 8 tight end by Rivals.com.

"We're very excited about this class," Friedgen said. "There is a lot of talent at a number of different positions and we've also filled a number of needs."

The signees hail from eight states, including Maryland/Washington D.C. (5), Virginia (5), New Jersey (5), New York (2), Georgia (3), South Carolina (2), Ohio (1) and Connecticut (1). The Terps also signed one international product, DB **Michael Carter**, of Windsor, Ontario, who played for Erie Community College last season.

Baltz is one of the signees who will be eligible for spring practice after graduating early from high school. He enrolled in classes at the university in January and will have four years of eligilibility beginning in the fall.
