## Pre-Spring Notes

### TERPS OPEN SPRING PRACTICE...

- Maryland will open spring football practice on Saturday, March 10. The team will practice three days before taking a week off for spring break. The Terps resume workouts on March 27 and will practice each Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday leading up to the Red-White Spring game on Saturday, April 21. The game will kick off at 1 p.m. in Capital One Field at Byrd Stadium. Admission to the game is free.
- Head coach **Randy Edsall** and the Terps will have to replace a number of key performers from last season, but they do return 15 offensive and defensive starters, as well as punter/place-kicker **Nick Ferrara**.
- Senior defensive lineman **Joe Vellano**, a 2011 second team All-American, and linebackers **Demetrius Hartsfield** and **Darin Drakeford** headline the 10 starters back on defense. Vellano led the FBS last season in tackles by a defensive lineman (7.8 per game), Hartsfield was an honorable mention All-ACC pick and Drakeford had a league-high tying four forced fumbles.
- The offense returns five starters, including three of its top four receivers from last season in wideouts **Kevin Dorsey** and **Kerry Boykins**, and tight end **Matt Furstenburg**. Junior **C.J. Brown**, who started five games in 2011, assumes No. 1 quarterback duties. Brown rushed for 574 yards, a Maryland single-season record for a quarterback.

- **Practice Access:** Spring workouts, which will be held at the football practice facility, are closed. The exceptions are March 10, 27 and April 3, 10, 17. Those practices are open to the media.
- **Interview Availability:** Coach Edsall will address the media at a news conference on March 6 as well as post practice on March 10, 27 and April 3, 10, 17. Players will be available on those days as well. Coach Edsall and players will also be available after the Red-White Spring game.

**QUICK HITTERS...**

- The five Maryland players who received 2011 postseason recognition return to the squad this year - DL **Keith Bowers** (freshman All-ACC), LB **Lorne Goree** (freshman All-ACC), LB **Demetrius Hartsfield** (honorable mention All-ACC), DL **Andre Monroe** (freshman All-American) and DL **Joe Vellano** (second team All-American).
- The Terrapins return 75 percent of the offensive and defensive two-deep from the end of last season. There are 17 of the 22 offensive players back and 16 of 22 defenders. In addition, eight of the 12 members of the final special teams two-deep is back in 2012.
- Maryland had 15 seniors on the 2011 roster, but just 12 of those players were listed on the two-deep at some point during the year. There are currently 18 seniors listed on the 2012 spring roster.
- Eleven of Maryland's top 13 tacklers from 2011 are back this season, including Hartsfield, who had a team-high 108 stops, and safety **Eric Franklin**, who was second with 106.
- Six of the top seven sack producers from 2011 are back this season, including leading sack producer **Monroe** who had 5.0, the second most by a Maryland freshman in the last nine years (**Adrian Moten** - 5.5 in 2007; **Merriman** - 5.0 in 2002).
- Three Terps ended 2011 ranked among the top 12 in the ACC in tackles. **Hartsfield** was second at 12.0 per game and **Franklin** was sixth at 8.8. **Vellano** was 12th with 7.8 per contest.
- There are 17 players on the roster who have started on the defensive side of the ball. In addition to the 10 returning starters (see chart on page 3), DL **Justin Anderson**, DB **Matt Robinson**, DL **Isaiah Ross** and LB **Kenny Tate** were all starters or significant contributors prior to suffering injuries in 2011. **Goree** and DL **A.J. Francis** have also started games.
- There are just two returning starters (**Bennett Fulper** and **Justin Gilbert**) on Maryland's offensive line, but six players have started in their careers. **De'Onte Arnett**, **Josh Cary**, **Sal Conaboy** and **Peter White** have also started.
- Three new scholarship players joined the program

this semester. DB **Isaac Goins**, DB **Levern Jacobs** and DL **Quinton Jefferson** will take part in spring practice. **Goins** is a junior-college player who will have two years of eligibility left. **Jacobs** attended prep school last fall and **Jefferson** signed with the Terps in 2011, but did not matriculate in the fall due to a medical issue. **Jacobs** and **Jefferson** will have four years of eligibility. In addition, WR **Nigel King** will be able to practice with the team. **King** joined the Terps last spring out of high school, but was unable to practice in the fall due an NCAA eligibility issue.

• Nine bowl teams from last year appear on Maryland's 2012 schedule: Temple (Gildan New Mexico Bowl), West Virginia (Discover Orange Bowl), Wake Forest (Franklin American Mortgage Music City), Virginia (Chick-fil-A Bowl), NC State (Belk Bowl), Georgia Tech (Hyundai Sun Bowl), Clemson (Discover Orange Bowl), Florida State (Champs Sports Bowl) and North Carolina (AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl).

**ON THE SHELF...**

There will be a few Terps unable to participate during the spring due to offseason surgery and recovery. That list includes **Tyrek Cheeseboro** (knee), **Makinton Dorleant** (knee), **Nick Ferrara** (hip), **Kenny Tate** (knee) and **Peter White** (shoulder). In addition, **Ian Evans**, **Bennett Fulper**, **Matt Robinson**, **Isaiah Ross** and **Dave Stinebaugh** will have limited reps for a variety of ailments.

**TERPS SHINE IN THE CLASSROOM...**

Maryland football is coming off one of its best academic semesters in recent memory.

The 2011 fall semester team GPA was 2.544:

- This was the second highest (spring 2011 was 2.589) team semester GPA in eight years (16 semesters).
- This was only the second time in eight years (16 semesters) that football had a semester team GPA above 2.50.
- This is the only time in eight years (16 semesters) that football posted semester team GPA's of 2.50 or higher in consecutive semesters.

The cumulative team GPA at the end of the fall semester was 2.554:

- This was the highest team cumulative GPA in eight years (16 semesters).
- This marks the only time in eight years (16 semesters) that football posted a team cumulative GPA above 2.5.

• Has played in 31 career games with 22 starts ... started 10 games at center in 2011 before being sidelined with an injury ... two-time Academic-All-ACC choice.

• Six starts in 18 career games ... made his first start of 2011 against Notre Dame after returning from injury.
- TE Matt Furstenburg Sr.-3V 6-4, 245**  
• A two-year starter who has played in 38 career games... fourth on the team in receptions with 31 and receiving yards with 348... caught two TD passes in 2011.

- WR Kevin Dorsey Sr.-3V 6-2, 205**  
• Led the team in receptions (45) and receiving yards (573) in 2011 ... had eight catches for a career-high 124 against Miami.

- WR Kerry Boykins Sr.-3V 6-0, 190**  
• Played in all 12 games last year including five starts... had a career high 101 receiving yards against Virginia on six catches... also a special teams standout who had seven tackles leading the team.

- OL Max Garcia 2V 6-4, 290**  
• Started all 12 games at left tackle in 2011 ... played in 14 career games.

- OL Andrew Gonnella 3V 6-5, 295**  
• Three-year starter at guard who had 26 career starts in 30 games ... started the first five games of 2011 at left guard before going down to an injury... former walk-on who earned a scholarship prior to the 2009 season.

- OL R.J. Dill 3V 6-7, 300**  
• A three-year starter at tackle who played in 37 games with 33 starts ... had the longest consecutive start streak at the end of 2011 with 30.

- QB Danny O'Brien 2V 6-3, 215**  
• A 2010 freshman All-American ... ranks eighth on Maryland's career passing list with 4,086 yards ... 17 career starts in 22 career games.

- WR Quintin McCree 4V 6-1, 190**  
• Played in 10 games in 2011 all of which were starts... averaged 71.3 receiving yards per game in the last six games of the year.

- RB Davin Meggett 4V 5-9, 215**  
• Led the team in rushing as a junior and senior ... played in all 50 games dating back to his true freshman season ... ranks seventh in school history in career rushing yards (2,411).

**DE Marcus Whitfield Jr.-1V 6-3, 245**  
 • Played in eight games and started the final five of 2011 ... had 11 total tackles including 3.5 tackles for loss... recorded 2.5 sacks and one forced fumble.

**DE Keith Bowers So.-1V 6-2, 260**  
 • Played in all 12 games and made 11 starts as a true freshman ... tied for fourth on the team in tackles for loss with six... had a career high-nine tackles against BC.

**DT Joe Vellano Sr.-3V 6-2, 285**  
 • A 2011 second team All-American by AP and Walter Camp ... had a career-high 20 tackles against Georgia Tech last year ... led the FBS in tackles by a DL in 2011 (7.8 pg).

**DT Andre Monroe So.-1V 6-0, 275**  
 • A 2011 freshman All-American who had five starts on the season ... tied Joe Vellano for team-high with 7.5 tackles for loss ... team-high 5.0 sacks in 2011.

**LB Demetrius Hartsfield Sr.-3V 6-2, 235**  
 • Honorable mention All-ACC in 2011 ... active career leader in tackles (260) ... ranked second in ACC in tackles in 2011 (12.0 pg).

**LB Darin Drakeford Sr.-3V 6-0, 240**  
 • Started all eight games he appeared in last season ... averaged 8.5 tackles for game... tied for conference lead with a team-high four forced fumbles.

**LB Alex Twine So.-1V 6-1, 220**  
 • Played in 11 games with four starts as a true freshman last season ... had a career day against Notre Dame with career highs in tackles (12), solo tackles (7), tackles for loss (3.0) and had a sack.

**S A.J. Hendy So.-1V 6-1, 195**  
 • One of only two true freshmen to start at safety for Maryland since 1993 ... played in nine games including starting the final three games of the season.

**S Eric Franklin Jr.-2V 6-2, 205**  
 • Started all 12 games at safety in 2011 ... led the team in total tackles (106) and solo stops (64) ... ranked sixth in the ACC in tackles per game with 8.8.

**CB Dexter McDougle So.-1V 5-10, 190**  
 • Started all 12 games ... led the team with six pass breakups and tied for the team lead with three interceptions.

### Starters Lost (1)

**CB Cameron Chism 4V 5-10, 190**  
 • Played in 44 career games including 32 starts... finished his career with seven interceptions and 16 pass breakups... had two interception returns for a touchdown in 2011 against Miami and Clemson.

## STAFF ADJUSTMENTS...

During the offseason there were some changes to the Maryland coaching staff.

- **Mike Locksley** was hired in December as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. Locksley, a native of Washington, D.C., returned to Maryland after previously spending six years (1997-02) as an assistant coach on the Terrapins staff. A veteran coach with over 20 years experience, Locksley most recently spent four years (2005-08) as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach for the University of Illinois and two-plus years (2009-11) as head coach at the University of New Mexico. Locksley helped the Fighting Illini offense improve from No. 86 nationally in total offense (338.1 yards per game) in 2005 to No. 19 (438.3 yards per game) in 2008. The Illinois offense ranked in the top 10 nationally (No. 10 in 2006; No. 5 in 2007) in rushing yards. Known for strong recruiting skills, Locksley was listed as a top-25 recruiter in the nation three different times (2003, 2005, 2006) and was a finalist for 2007 recruiter of the year by Rivals.com.

- **Brian Stewart** was hired in January as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach. A former NFL defensive coordinator, Stewart recently completed a successful two-year stint with the Houston Cougars, who ended 2011 with a 13-1 record and a No. 14 ranking in the final USA Today poll. The Cougars had one of the best defenses in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in 2011, ranking in the top 15 in five categories: red-zone scoring (second – 67 percent), interceptions (t-third – 21), tackles for loss (sixth – 7.7 per game), turnovers gained (t-10th – 31) and opponent passing efficiency (12th – 111.75 rating). Houston also improved from 96th nationally in scoring defense (32.2 points per game) in 2010 to 35th (22.4) this past year. Stewart went to Houston after an eight-year run as an NFL assistant, including two years (2007-08) as the defensive coordinator with Dallas.

- With the change to a 3-4 defense, **Lyndon Johnson** will now oversee both outside linebacker positions (Sam and Will), while **Andre Powell** will take over as special-teams coordinator, in addition to his running back chores. Last season, Johnson was responsible for the Star position on the defensive side of the ball. Powell was a special-teams coordinator during each of his last two stops – Clemson (2007-10) and North Carolina (2001-06). He handled both running backs and special-teams duties the final three seasons at each job.

- Defensive line coach **Greg Gattuso** was elevated to assistant head coach. The former head coach of Duquesne (1992-04), Gattuso spent six seasons (2005-10) as the defensive line coach at Pittsburgh.

- Former offensive lineman **Pete DeSouza** is now a student assistant coach. DeSouza, who had not played since his redshirt freshman season (2010) when he was injured in a traffic accident, took a medical hardship.

**5...The Terps scored five times on defense in 2011 which was tied for sixth in the FBS.**

**6...Maryland ranked tied for sixth in the FBS in fewest penalties committed per game (4.1) and 11th in fewest yards penalized (36.2).**

**13.5...13.5 of the team's 26 sacks (52 percent) in 2011 were posted by freshmen – Andre Monroe had a team-high 5.0, Lorne Goree had 3.5 and Keith Bowers posted 2.5.**

**15...C.J. Brown's 574 rushing yards in 2011 rank No. 15 on the ACC single-season list for quarterbacks.**

**25...Joe Vellano's 25 consecutive starts are tops on the team.**

**260...Demetrius Hartsfield has 260 career tackles which leads all active players. Kenny Tate is second with 197**
