- Maryland has captured two NCAA championships (1973 & 1975).
- Maryland has played in the NCAA championship game nine times (1971, 1973, 1974, 1975, 1976, 1979, 1995, 1997, 1998)
- Maryland has played in 29 NCAA Tournaments, the third most of any school, behind only Johns Hopkins (34) and Virginia (30).
- Maryland has an overall record of 39-27 in NCAA Tournament games, a .591 winning percentage.
- Maryland has hosted the NCAA Championship 10 times (1972, 1979, 1989, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1999, 2000), more than any other school.
- Maryland's Byrd Stadium held every lacrosse attendance record prior to the 2003 championships at M&T Bank Stadium in Baltimore. Byrd set the record which was broken last season, drawing a crowd of 30,580 to a 1997 semifinal game. The stadium also drew a record 26,229 to a title game in 1995.
- Byrd Stadium now ranks sixth for the record for highest championship weekend attendance of 72,389 set in 1995.




