

2007-08 SEASON RECAP

The 2007-08 University of Maryland wrestling program took the collegiate wrestling world by storm and announced itself as a major player on the national scene.

The Terrapins put together a 16-4 record in dual meets, including a perfect 5-0 record in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the school's first ACC championship since 1973.

Five wrestlers won individual championships in the conference and the team sent six competitors to the NCAA Championship, overall.

Hudson Taylor made waves, nationally, in only his sophomore season in the 197-pound division. Taylor went 37-3 on the season with a staggering 18 pins. Taylor was ranked as highly as fifth in the country during the regular season, but proved he was even better than that in the NCAA Championship.

Taylor finished third in the NCAA's in his division, going 6-1 overall in St. Louis. Included in his victories was a 9-6 decision against No. 1 ranked defending national champion Josh Glenn of American University. Taylor then defeated No. 8 Craig Bester of Nebraska to become the school's first All-American since 1997.

In addition to Taylor, Steven Bell (133), Jon Kohler (141), Brian Letters (157), Mike Letts (174) and Eric Medina (149) all advanced to St. Louis as well. The Terps recorded 24 points to tie for 21st overall in the team standings.

The season began with the Terps winning two of three meets at the Fighting Scot Duals in Edinboro, Pa. The Terps knocked off Army and Mercyhurst before dropping a close battle with host Edinboro.

After a loss at powerhouse Penn State, Maryland placed third at the Body Bar Invitational in Ithaca, N.Y. with Medina and Josh Haines taking home individual titles.

Maryland showed its first glimpse of the success to come at the Northeast Duals November 24 in Troy, N.Y. The Terrapins knocked off Michigan, 18-16, in the first matchup of the day and then crushed Appalachian State

before losing to a really strong Central Michigan squad.

Maryland's home season began December 2 with a 25-9 victory against a powerful Lehigh program. The Terps built off the success of the Lehigh victory the next week with easy home wins against Rider and Rutgers, respectively.

Ranked 22nd in the nation, the Terps had a good showing at the Southern Scuffle December 29-30 in Greensboro, N.C., placing fifth out of 28 programs. Taylor won the individual title at 197 pounds.

After a good showing in Greensboro, the Terps faced a difficult matchup at local rival

and 22nd ranked Navy. The Terrapins made a statement in Annapolis, Md. that night, defeating the Midshipmen for the first time in 22 years, winning seven of 10 matches for a hard-fought, 21-18 victory.

Following the big win at Navy, the Terps started conference play January 13 at North Carolina. The Terps edged the Tar Heels, 19-17, and proceeded to win their next three conference matches easily, defeating Virginia Tech, NC State and Duke at home.

With eight straight dual victories under its belt, Maryland had its winning streak snapped at Penn February 2 in Philadelphia, falling to the Quakers by a score of 19-16.

However, the Terps would not lose a dual the rest of the way, winning four in a row to close the regular season.

The Terps finished the season February 24 with a close match against the rival Virginia Cavaliers in Charlottesville, Va. Maryland outlasted Virginia, 16-15, avoiding a loss by more than three points in the final matchup. The win gave Maryland its second straight 5-0 conference season.

After a perfect conference season, Maryland went into the ACC Championship as the favorites, especially considering it was the host institution.

Again, Virginia proved a tough adversary, but the Terps would not be denied, winning their first ACC title in 25 years, registering 86.5 team points. Virginia finished second with 84.5 points.

The Terrapins' individual champions included Bell, Kohler, Letters, Letts and Taylor. Medina came in second and received an at-large bid to the NCAA Championship.

Other than Taylor's third-place showing at the NCAA Championships, Bell had a good showing in St. Louis, winning three of five matches.

Following the season, Taylor was named ACC Wrestler of the Year and was also named the ACC Scholar Athlete for wrestling.

Head coach Pat Santoro was named the ACC Coach of the Year. However, Santoro resigned as head coach in April to take the head coaching job at Lehigh. Maryland replaced Santoro with former Stanford head coach Kerry McCoy, one of the greatest heavyweight wrestlers in the history of the United States. At Stanford, McCoy led the Cardinal to a 19th-place finish at the NCAA Championships in 2008.
