## QUICK HITS

- Maryland is ranked No. 5 in the *Associated Press* poll and sixth in the *USA Today/ESPN* Coaches poll.
- Maryland is one of four teams to be featured on the ESPN Selection Show on Monday night.
- The Terps will make their 17th NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Maryland has been awarded the No. 2 seed the last two years.
- The University of Maryland will host the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament on March 23 & 25.
- It will be the second time in four years Maryland has hosted the postseason event. The last time was in 2005 when this year's senior class were freshmen.
- Other sites selected for the first and second rounds are The Pit/Bob King Court on the campus of the University of New Mexico, LSU's Pete Maravich Center, Wells Fargo Arena at Iowa State and Stanford's Maples Pavilion. Those sites will play its games on March 22 and 24.
- Games played on March 23 and 25 other than Comcast Center will be at Bridgeport Arena at Harbor Yard hosted by Fairfield University, Old Dominion's the Constant Convocation Center and Purdue's Mackey Arena.
- The regional sites will be at Greensboro, Oklahoma City, New Orleans and Spokane.
- The NCAA Final Four will be played on April 6 and 8 at St. Pete Times Forum in Tampa, Fla.

**TERPS AWAIT TOURNAMENT FATE**

- Fifth-ranked Maryland will be making its fifth-straight NCAA Tournament appearance. The NCAA will reveal the 2008 bracket and seedings on the ESPN Selection Show Special on Monday, March 17 at 7 p.m.
- The Terps will also be making their 17th all-time appearance in the NCAA Tournament. They have advanced to at least the second round in each of the last four seasons, winning the National Championship in 2006.
- The University of Maryland will host eight teams for the first and second rounds of the tournament. The Terps were selected as one of eight predetermined sites in the summer of 2006. It will be the last year the NCAA Tournament will be played at eight first and second round sites. Beginning next year, the tournament will return to 16 first and second round hosts, of which the University of Maryland has already been selected.

**TERPS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT**

- Making its 17th NCAA Tournament appearance overall, the Terrapins advance to the the tournament for the fifth-straight year, the first time since the team made six-consecutive trips to the Big Dance from 1988-1993.
- The Terrapins have posted a 21-15 record in 16 appearances, winning the National Championship in 2006 as the No. 2 seed in the Albuquerque Region.
- Maryland only appearance in the national championship game came in 2006. The Terps have advanced to the Final Four three times in the history of the program (1982, 1989, 2006). They have also been to the Elite Eight five times and the Sweet Sixteen six times, with both last appearances coming in 2006.
- In 1989, Maryland earned the program's only No. 1 seed to date. It has been the No. 2 seed six times, including the last two seasons. Maryland was also the third seed once in 1983 and has never been the numbers four, five, 10 or 11 seed.
- In its four NCAA Tournament appearances under head coach Brenda Frese, Maryland improved its seeding from a No. 12 in 2003-04, to a No. 7 in 2004-05, to a No. 2 seed the last two seasons.

**IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT RECORD BOOK**

- Maryland's 13-point comeback in the 2006 national championship game tied the second-largest title-game comeback in NCAA Tournament history. The overtime was only the second in NCAA Championship game history.
- That year was also the third time in NCAA history two teams from the same conference squared off for the national championship and the first time three teams from the same league advanced to the Final Four. The Terrapins faced both North Carolina (Final Four) and Duke (championship) to win the title. Both UNC and Duke were No. 1 seeds, as well.
- Head coach Brenda Frese was the fifth-youngest coach ever to win an NCAA Division I women's basketball championship (35 years, 11 months, five days). The only younger coaches on the list are: Old Dominion's Marianne Stanley (31 in 1985), Southern California's Linda Sharp (32 in 1983), Purdue's Carolyn Peck (33 in 1999) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (34 in 1987).
- The Terps are the only team in the history of the NCAA Tournament to win the national championship while playing two overtime games en route to claiming the title. They are only the fifth team overall to play in two overtime games in one NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Maryland's Shay Doron went 6-for-6 from the free throw line, tying for the fourth-best foul shooting performance in the NCAA Championship game.
- Maryland was the only team in the 2006 Final Four to have played in the inaugural NCAA Tournament Final Four in 1982.

**TOURNAMENT TESTED**

- The Terps enter the postseason with extensive NCAA Tournament experience. Four starters from this year's team started in the 2006 National Championship game.
- Overall, seven active Terps have NCAA Tournament experience, with six having played in at least eight tournament games.
- Junior Christie Marrone has the least amount of experience of the seven who have played in the NCAA Tournament. She played in one game her freshman year at Virginia Tech.
- Seniors Crystal Langhorne and Ashleigh Newman have played in all 10 NCAA Tournament games of their careers, two shy of the record held by former Terrapin Shay Doron. Senior Jade Perry has played in nine tournament games, which ties for the sixth-most among all-time Terrapins, while juniors Marissa Coleman and Kristi Toliver have played in eight tournament games, tying for the ninth-most tournament appearances in school history.

**ELITE COMPANY**

- Maryland is one of only four schools to claim NCAA titles in both men's and women's basketball, joining Connecticut, North Carolina and Stanford.
- The Terps are also one of only two schools to have national titles in men's and women's basketball and football.

- Boasting a 199-83 mark, Frese made stops as head coach at Ball State and Minnesota, before settling in College Park, where she has been for six seasons. At all three programs, she has made amazing turnarounds, earning the 2002 Associated Press National Coach of the Year honor.

**TOLIVER THREATENS SCHOOL RECORD**

- First team All-ACC performer Kristi Toliver is just one assist from tying the ACC and Maryland single-season mark which has stood since 1978.
- Former Terrapin great and hall of famer Tara Heiss dished out 249 assists during the 1977-78 campaign. Toliver has handed out 248 assists so far this season.

**TERPS ARE TOP SHOOTING TEAM IN THE NATION**

- With the latest NCAA rankings released on March 13 the Terrapins were the top shooting team in the country, ranking first in field goal shooting, knocking down 50 percent of their shot attempts.
- Maryland is ranked in the top 10 in five more categories. It boasts the second-best scoring average in the nation, ranked fourth in rebounding margin and sixth in scoring margin. The Terps' 90.9 percent winning percentage (reflecting a 30-3 record) is ranked fifth in the country.
- In the individual rankings, senior Crystal Langhorne is second in the nation in field goal shooting. She led the country in the category the last two years. Junior Kristi Toliver is fourth in the nation in assists per game. Both are also ranked in the top 100 in several different categories.
- Senior Laura Harper boasts the third-best shooting percentage in the nation, while Marissa Coleman is in the top 65 in free throw percentage.

**TWO TERRAPINS SELECTED WOODEN FINALISTS**

- ACC Player of the Year Crystal Langhorne and junior Kristi Toliver were named one of 17 finalists for the John R. Wooden Award, presented to the nation's top collegiate player. The winner of the award will be announced on April 12 at the Los Angeles Athletic Club.
- Maryland and Connecticut were the only teams with two balloted players, while the ACC had three total.

**TERPS RECEIVE HONORS BY NATIONAL PUBLICATIONS**

- While Maryland took a break from basketball after the ACC Tournament, two national publications handed out its postseason honors.
- Sports Illustrated announced its All-American team with junior Kristi Toliver earning a spot on the first team. Senior Crystal Langhorne and junior Marissa Coleman were named to the second team.
- ESPN.com selected Toliver and Langhorne to its second team All-American squad.
- Maryland was the only team to have more than one player selected in either publication's honors.
