QUICK HITS

- Maryland is ranked fifth in the final *Associated Press* poll, appearing in the top five every week.
- The University of Maryland is hosting the NCAA Tournament first and second rounds for the second time in four years.
- The Terps' No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament is the second time in the history of the program they have earned a top seed.
- The Terrapins' last non-conference loss at Comcast Center was against Ohio State in the second round of the 2005 NCAA Tournament, a string of 30-straight non-conference victories at home.
- Maryland is undefeated at home this season, winning a school-record 20 games on its home court, one short of what is believed to be the all-time record set by UNLV in 1978-79.
- Crystal Langhorne became only the seventh player in ACC history to grab 1,200 career rebounds.
- Junior Kristi Toliver broke the ACC's single-season assists record vs. Coppin State, a record which had stood for 30 years.
- Junior Marissa Coleman is just two points shy of 1,500 for her career. She is also three free throws from breaking the school's single-season record.
- Junior Laura Harper needs just one block to break the senior class school record.
- Maryland surpassed its win total from a year ago. Last year's team went 28-6 overall and 10-4 in ACC play.
- Maryland has recorded four-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in school history.
- For the first time in the history of the program, Maryland has won 10 ACC games in three-consecutive seasons. Its 13 league wins and 92.9 winning percentage both tie school records.
- The Terps' four All-ACC selections are a school record. Crystal Langhorne is Maryland's first four-time All-ACC honoree and one of just 10 in the history of the ACC to be named to the first team three times.
- Marissa Coleman's three-straight All-ACC selections makes her one of four Terrapins all-time to be named all-conference at least three times.
- The Terps are one of two teams in NCAA history to have four players with 1,300 career points on the roster (along with 01-02 Connecticut). They are one of 12 known teams with four 1,000-point scorers.
- The Terps have had at least one player with a double-double in 29 of their 34 games and lead the country with 46 team double-doubles.
- Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver are finalists for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.
- Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver were selected WBCA Region II All-Americans.
- Kristi Toliver is a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard.

NO. 1-SEEDED TERPS MAKE FIFTH-STRAIGHT NCAA 2ND ROUND APPEARANCE

- The Spokane Region's No. 1 seed, Maryland advances to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the fifth-straight year, a first in the history of the program. The Terps take on eighth-seeded Nebraska on Tuesday, March 25 at approximately 9:30 p.m. The Terrapins are undefeated at home so far this season, winning 20 games at Comcast Center, tied for the third-longest active home winning streak in the NCAA.
- The Terps also host third-seeded Duke and sixth-seeded Arizona State at Comcast Center for the second round of the NCAA Tournament on Tuesday night at 7 p.m. Both teams are looking to advance to the Sweet Sixteen in the Oklahoma City Regional.
- It is the second time in four years the Terrapins host the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament. The last time the event was held in Comcast Center was when this year's senior class were freshmen in 2005. Maryland's last loss to a non-conference team in College Park was to Ohio State in the second round of the 2005 tournament.
- The first and second round games will be televised on ESPN or ESPN2. Pam Ward will be the play-by-play with Nancy Lieberman providing analysis. Holly Rowe will be on the sidelines.

TERPS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Making its 17th NCAA Tournament appearance overall, the Terrapins advance to the the tournament for the fifth-straight year, the first time since the team made six-consecutive trips to the Big Dance from 1988-1993.
- The Terrapins have posted a 22-15 record in 17 appearances, winning the National Championship in 2006 as the No. 2 seed in the Albuquerque Region. They advance to the second round for the fifth-straight year, a first in the history of the program.
- Maryland's only appearance in the national championship game came in 2006. The Terps have advanced to the Final Four three times in the history of the program (1982, 1989, 2006). They have also been to the Elite Eight five times and the Sweet Sixteen six times, with both last appearances coming in 2006.
- In 1989, Maryland earned the program's only No. 1 seed to date. It has been the No. 2 seed six times, including the last two seasons. Maryland was also the third seed once in 1983 and has never been the numbers four, five, 10 or 11 seed.
- In its four NCAA Tournament appearances under head coach Brenda Frese, Maryland improved its seeding from a No. 12

in 2003-04, to a No. 7 in 2004-05, to a No. 2 seed in 2005-06 and 2006-07. The Terps earned their first No. 1 seed under Frese this season and their first since 1989.

FRESE CLAIMS 200TH VICTORY

- Maryland head coach Brenda Frese won her 200th game on Sunday afternoon, claiming an 80-66 victory over Coppin State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Frese is in her ninth season as a head coach, making stops at Ball State and Minnesota, before landing in College Park in 2002-03.
- Frese boasts a 200-83 mark making amazing turnarounds at all three programs. The 2002 *Associated Press* Coach of the Year, she has been at College Park for six seasons, recording a 143-54 mark on the Terrapin sideline.

NCAA TOURNAMENT IN COLLEGE PARK

- College Park has played host to the NCAA Tournament in eight years. The Terps in 10 NCAA Tournament games on their home court, going 8-2. Maryland is the only school in the state to ever host an NCAA Women's Basketball Division I Tournament game.
- The Terps were last hosts to an NCAA Tournament matchup in 2005, falling to Ohio State, 75-65, in the second round. The Buckeyes were the second seed at the time of the meeting. They are also the last non-conference team to defeat the Terps at Comcast Center.

ACC IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- The ACC received the third-most number of NCAA Tournament selections, earning six bids. Only the Big East and the Big 12 garnered more bids with a tournament-high eight each. The SEC received five bids.

TOURNAMENT TESTED

- Entering the NCAA Tournament, the Terps boasted plenty of postseason experience. Four starters from this year's team started in the 2006 National Championship game.
- Six of the players have played in at least nine tournament games. Senior Crystal Langhorne has started a school-record 11 NCAA Tournament games over her career.
- Langhorne and classmate Ashleigh Newman have played in all 11 NCAA Tournament games of their careers, one shy of the record held by former Terrapin Shay Doron. Senior Jade Perry has played in 10 games, which ties for the fifth-most among all-time Terrapins, while juniors Marissa Coleman and Kristi Toliver have played in nine tournament games, tying for the seventh-most appearances in school history.

TERPS VS. THE FIELD

- Maryland is 14-3 versus the field of 64, facing 14 teams who earned NCAA tournament bids.
- The Terps picked up a pair of wins each against Duke and Virginia. They also defeated LSU, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Florida State, Georgia Tech, UC Santa Barbara, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Temple and NCAA first-round opponent Coppin State.

- Maryland's only three losses of the season came against the New Orleans Region top seed, North Carolina, the No. 2 seed in the Greensboro Region, Rutgers, and Duke, who is the third seed in the Oklahoma City Regional.

LANGHORNE'S REACHES ANOTHER MILESTONE

- Crystal Langhorne has grabbed exactly 1,200 rebounds in her career, reaching the milestone in the NCAA Tournament first-round win vs. Coppin State. Only six other players in ACC history have grabbed as many rebounds. She is currently tied or sixth all-time in the league with Charlotte Smith.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Maryland has won a school-record 20 home games so far during this campaign, breaking the program mark set during the 2005-06 campaign. It ties the third-longest active streak in the NCAA. Hartford has the longest active win streak at 26.

- Maryland finished the home season undefeated, winning 19 home victories. The 20th home win came in the first round of the NCAA Tournament and is believed to be an NCAA record. UNLV posted 21 wins at home in 1978-79, before the NCAA.

UNGRACIOUS HOSTS

- Completing the non-conference schedule capturing the Terrapin Classic, Maryland has a 31-game home win streak against non-conference opponents.
- The Terps' last non-conference loss at Comcast Center was to Ohio State in the second round of the 2005 NCAA Tournament.
- Since moving to Comcast Center in 2002-03, the Terps have gone 50-4 in non-conference games. The four losses were to teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of the meeting.

TERPS VS. THE BIG 12

- Maryland is 8-2 all-time vs. Big 12 teams, including a win this season over Oklahoma, 76-66, in the State Farm Tip-Off Classic in Chapel Hill, N.C.
- The Terps have faced three Big 12 teams in the NCAA Tournament, winning all three matchups. The last meeting against a Big 12 opponent in the tournament came in 2006 when the Terps defeated the then-defending national champions, Baylor, 82-63, in the Sweet 16 in Albuquerque, N.M. Other tournament wins over the Big 12 include Missouri in 1982 and Texas in 1989.

TERPS LEAD THE NATION IN DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Maryland's 46 team double-doubles are the most for any team in the nation this season. At least one Terp has achieved the feat in 29 of the team's 34 games. Five different Terrapins have recorded a double-double this season.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

- In 34 games this season, the Terps have recorded 46 double-doubles and at least one double-double has been posted in all but five games.
- National Player of the Year candidate Crystal Langhorne has recorded a team-leading 14 double-doubles this season. She recorded her 50th-career double-double in the win at Boston College. Twelve of those double-doubles have come in the last 19 games. Harper has 12, her latest coming against Duke in the ACC semifinals.
- Junior Marissa Coleman is third on the team with 10 double-doubles so far, most recently achieving the feat at NC State, Junior Kristi Toliver has accounted for seven double-doubles. She has achieved the feat achieving double figures in points and assists.
- Senior Jade Perry recorded double-doubles three times, as well, reaching double digits in points and rebounds.

GOOD FOR AT LEAST 10

- National Player of the Year candidate Crystal Langhorne can be counted on for at least 10 points a game, reaching double figures in 26 of 28 games this season.
- In her career, Langhorne has reached double figures in 122 career games (out of 131), which ranks seventh all-time in NCAA history.

TERPS ARE TOP SHOOTING TEAM IN THE NATION

- With the latest NCAA rankings released on March 13, the Terrapins were the top shooting team in the country, ranking first in field goal shooting, knocking down 50 percent of their shot attempts.
- Maryland is ranked in the top 10 in five more categories. It boasts the second-best scoring average in the nation, ranked fourth in rebounding margin and sixth in scoring margin. The Terps' 90.9 percent winning percentage (reflecting a 30-3 record) is ranked fifth in the country.
- In the individual rankings, senior Crystal Langhorne is second in the nation in field goal shooting. She led the country in the category the last two years. Junior Kristi Toliver is fourth in the nation in assists per game. Both are also ranked in the top 100 in several different categories.
- Senior Laura Harper boasts the third-best shooting percentage in the nation, while Marissa Coleman is in the top 65 in free throw percentage.

DRAINING THREES

- Maryland has made at least a three pointer in 120-consecutive games. The streak dates back to Jan. 29, 2005 at Arizona.

BOARDING SCHOOL

- Maryland, the leading rebounding team in the nation the last two years, has shown that controlling the glass can affect the outcomes of games. The Terps are 111-9 when outrebounding opponents since 2004-05 and 6-14 when they collect the same or fewer caroms than their opponents.
- The Terps have outrebounded their opponents in 29 games this season, coming out even against Ohio State and Rutgers. Maryland was outrebounded for the first time since last year's ACC Tournament semifinals in the win over Middle Tennessee State and then again at North Carolina.

TOLIVER BREAKS ACC ASSIST RECORD

- First team All-ACC performer Kristi Toliver broke the ACC's single-season assist record, a mark which had stood for 30 years. The record was perviously held by former Terrapin and Hall of Famer Tara Heiss. She had dished 249 assists during the 1977-78 campaign.
- Toliver has handed out 255 assists so far this season.

COMING UP

- All the winners of the second round games advance to their respective Sweet Sixteens. The Spokane Regional begins on March 29 and the Elite Eight will be played on March 31. The games are being played at the Veterans Memorial Arena.
- All games will be televised on ESPN or ESPN2. Game times and brackets will be announced after each of the games.
