## MARYLAND LOOKING FOR FIRST FINAL FOUR APPEARANCE SINCE 1989

- After knocking out defending NCAA Champion Baylor in the Sweet Sixteen, third-ranked and second-seeded Maryland advances to the Albuquerque Regional final against Utah on Monday, March 27. The Terps are looking for their first Final Four appearance since 1989.
- Maryland is making its third-straight NCAA Tournament appearance under head coach Brenda Frese. The Elite Eight appearance is the first in her head coaching career. She did reach the regional semifinals as an assistant coach at Iowa State.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Making their first Sweet Sixteen since 1992, the third-ranked Terrapins eliminated defending NCAA Champion Baylor, 82-63, in the Albuquerque Region semifinal. Crystal Langhorne had a career-high tying 34 points to lead the Terps to victory.
- Langhorne had 20 points at the break, including a buzzer-beating layup to give Maryland a 35-28 lead, then opened the second half with a 14-2 run to put the game away. On the defensive end, the Terps limited the Bears to 33.8 percent shooting, including missing their first 15 of 16 shots to open the game.

## QUICKLY...

- The Terps end the season in the AP top five for the third time in school history.
- The Terps are looking for their first Final Four appearance since 1989.
- Maryland has posted its first 30-win season in school history.
- Maryland needs just 68 points to reach 3,000 for the season.
- Crystal Langhorne is the first player in school history with four 30-point games in a season. Her 34 points vs. Baylor are the most ever by a Terp in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Marissa Coleman and Utah's Julie Larsen both shoot 50 percent from three-point range.
- Maryland leads the nation in three-point shooting and rebounding margin.
- Crystal Langhorne is a Wooden Award and Kodak/WBCA All-American finalist.

Langhorne also had 15 rebounds for her league-leading 14th double-double of the season and the 32nd of her career. Freshman Marissa Coleman added 15 points and six rebounds and classmate Kristi Toliver had 12.

The Terps shot 50 percent from the floor, the 14th time this season they have shot 50 percent or better. They also outrebounded BU, 46-39. Maryland has outrebounded all but four of its opponents this season.

TERPS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Making its 15th NCAA Tournament appearance and third straight, Maryland is headed to the Elite Eight for the first time since 1992. It is also the first time since 1991-93 the Terps have made three-consecutive trips to the Big Dance.

In 15 NCAA appearances, the Terps have posted a 17-14 record all-time. En route to its fifth Elite Eight appearance in program history, Maryland has also reached the Final Four twice (1982 and 1989), while making six Sweet Sixteens, including its win over Baylor on Saturday night.

In 1989, the Terps earned their only No. 1 seed in program history. They have been a two seed five times, including this season. Maryland was also a No. 3 seed in 1983. The Terps have never been tabbed a four, five, 10 or 11 seed.

In its three NCAA Tournament appearances under head coach Brenda Frese, the Terps improved from a 12 seed in 2003-04, to a No. 7 seed in 2004-05 and, finally, a No. 2 seed this season. Their third-straight second-round appearance marks the first time since 1990 the Terps had accomplished that feat. Maryland is the only No. 1 or No. 2 seed this season that was not in the tournament four years ago.

**A QUICK LOOK BACK:** Maryland reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year, falling to No. 2-seed Ohio State, 75-65. A No. 7 seed, the Terps opened the tournament with a 65-55 victory over 10th-seeded Wisconsin-Green Bay. Maryland was hosting an NCAA Tournament game at home for the first time since 1993.

ACC IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The No. 1 conference in the nation, the ACC claimed seven NCAA Tournament berths, tying for the most this season. The Big East also had seven of its teams earn tournament bids.

- Duke and North Carolina claimed two of the four No. 1 seeds in the tournament. The Tar Heels are the top seed in the Cleveland Regional, while the Blue Devils are the top team in the Bridgeport Regional. The Terps are the No. 2 seed in the Albuquerque Regional, with Boston College garnering the eighth seed in the bracket. Virginia Tech was the seventh seed in the Bridgeport Regional, while fifth-seeded NC State and sixth-seeded Florida State were in the San Antonio Regional.
- Six of the ACC's seven teams earning a bid advanced to the second round, with only NC State (San Antonio) being eliminated, falling to Tulsa, 71-61. In the second round, both Virginia Tech (Bridgeport) and Florida State (San Antonio) were knocked out, but four teams advanced to the Sweet 16, the most of any conference. The Terps were the first ACC squad to advance to the Elite Eight, but Boston College fell to Utah in the Sweet Sixteen.
- The ACC, who has posted a 133-28 mark (82.6 percent) against non-conference opponents during the regular season, is 23-7 (.767) against non-conference NCAA Tournament teams.

**TWO SHARP SHOOTERS BATTLE IN THE ELITE EIGHT**

- Two of the nation's top three-point shooters will take to the floor in the Elite Eight in Albuquerque, N.M. Freshman Marissa Coleman and Utah's Julie Larsen both have amazing accuracy from three-point range, making 50 percent of their attempts.
- Larsen has made 13 more three pointers on the season than Coleman, netting 66 on 132 attempts. Coleman has connected on 53 of her 106 three-point shots.

**EXTRA CHARITY**

- Maryland has made 17 more free throws in three games of the NCAA Tournament than its opponents have attempted. The Terps have gone to the line 68 times, knocking down 55 (80.9 percent), while opponents have combined for just 38 attempts, while making 26.

- On the season, Maryland has made a school-record 636 free throws on 850 attempts, also a school record. Opponents, on the other hand, have gotten to the line 563 times, making 391 foul shots (69.4 percent).
- Maryland leads the nation with 18.2 free throws made per game and is ranked in the top 30 in the nation in free throw percentage.

**LANGHORNE'S FOUR 30-POINT GAMES SETS SCHOOL RECORD**

- Sophomore Crystal Langhorne's career-high tying 34-point outing in the Sweet Sixteen vs. Baylor marked the fourth time this season she has scored at least 30 points, setting the school single-season record. She broke Vicky Bullett's mark set during the 1987-88 season, which was also tied by Deanna Tate in 1988-89.
- Langhorne is the second player in school history to score 30-point games in back-to-back NCAA Tournament games. Deanna Tate netted 32 points and 30 points in the 1989 tournament.
- Langhorne, Tate and Bullett are the only three players in school history to reach 30 points in an NCAA Tournament game. Bullett did so vs. Ohio State in 1988, dropping 33.
- The 34 points against the Bears are also the most ever by a Terrapin in an NCAA Tournament game.

**MORE MILESTONE FOR LANGHORNE**

- Proving herself to be one of the top post players in school history, with her 34-point performance in the Sweet Sixteen, Crystal Langhorne became just the fourth player in school history to score 600 points in a season. She is also just the second player and the first since 1979-80 to tally 600 points and grab at least 300 rebounds in the season season. Kris Kirchner was the first player to accomplish that feat 26 years ago.
- Langhorne also broke the single-season free throws mark against #10/10 Baylor, having netted 147 on the year. She topped teammate Shay Doron's mark of 145 from last season. Langhorne is still the only player in school history to make 200 trips to the charity stripe, doing so this season and last season.
- Among the all-time Terrapin sophomores, Langhorne owns the school class marks for scoring (601) and rebounding (305). Both are also ranked among the top five single-season performances in school history.
- As mentioned above, Langhorne is the first player in school history to have four 30-point games in a season. Her 34 points against Baylor is the most ever scored by a Terp in an NCAA Tournament game.

**FRESE ONE OF FOUR NAISMITH FINALISTS**

- In her fourth season at the Terrapin helm, head coach Brenda Frese was named one of four finalists for the Naismith Award Women's Coach of the Year, the Atlanta Tipoff Club recently announced. Also among the finalists are LSU's Pokey Chatman, Ohio State's Jim Foster and North Carolina's Sylvia Hatchell.
- Frese has accomplished something no other coach has done this season, guiding her Terps to a win over North Carolina, the Tar Heels' only loss of the season. She has also mentored Maryland to a school record 30 wins while also guiding Maryland to its first Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight since 1992.
- In her first season in College Park, Frese's squad had won just 10 games. Four years later, she has lured three-straight top 10 recruiting classes, including two in the top five. The Terps are the only No. 1 or No. 2 seed in this year's tournament that was not in the postseason four years ago. The 2002 AP Coach of the Year, her teams have made 43 appearances in the AP poll (at Maryland and Minnesota), ranking 40th among active head

### LANGHORNE A KODAK/WBCA ALL-AMERICAN FINALIST

- Sophomore Crystal Langhorne is one of 48 finalists for the 10-member Kodak/WBCA All-American Team, which was announced today by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The top six players from eight regions were voted on by WBCA member coaches.
- The top six players in Region II are all ACC players, including Monique Currie and Lindsay Harding from Duke, Tamara James from Miami, and Erlana Larkins and Ivory Latta from North Carolina.
- Langhorne is also a finalist for the Wooden Award, presented to the nation's top women's basketball player.

### LANGHORNE A WOODEN AWARD FINALIST

- Sophomore Crystal Langhorne was one of 18 student-athletes who have been placed on the final voting ballot for the John R. Wooden Award, presented to the nation's top collegiate player, and the Wooden All-American team. The winner will be announced on Saturday, April 8 on CBS.
- Langhorne leads the nation in field goal shooting (66.4 percent) and was recently named first team All-ACC and was a first team All-ACC Tournament pick for the second-straight year. She helped the Terps reach the finals of the conference tournament, which included a 78-70 victory over then-No. 2 Duke in the semifinals, also snapping a 14-game losing streak to the Blue Devils.
- Langhorne also leads the ACC with 14 double-doubles on the season and has been named ACC Player of the Week twice this season. Langhorne was also the 2005 ACC Rookie of the Year.
- Langhorne is one of three ACC players on the ballot. She is joined by Duke's Monique Currie and North Carolina's Ivory Latta.

### MORE NCAA HISTORY

- Maryland's 41-point win over Sacred Heart in the first round at the Bryce Jordan Center was the program's largest ever in an NCAA Tournament game.

### 20-POINT SCORERS

- There is no doubt Maryland has had balanced scoring all season, with over 76 percent of its games featuring at least four double-figure scorers. The Terps have also had six different players score at least 20 points in a game, the most of any team in the ACC.
- North Carolina, Virginia and NC State have had five different players score at least 20 points, while Duke, the highest scoring team in the nation, has only had two different players tally 20. Clemson only had one player score 20 points this season.

### TAKING ON NO. 1... ALL OF THEM

- Maryland has faced the No. 1 ranked team in the nation four times this season and is 1-3 against those teams (ranking is at the time of the meeting and in either poll).
- The Terps faced their first No. 1 challenger at the Paradise Jam, when Tennessee, who was tabbed No. 1 in the coaches poll, battled Maryland for the Paradise Jam title. The Terps' second shot at No. 1 came two months later and they were more successful the next time. Maryland took down North Carolina, who was No. 1 in both polls, on Feb. 9, handing the Tar Heels their only loss of the season. After that win, Duke was bumped up to No. 1 in the Associated Press poll just days later... which turned out to be the Terps' next opponent. Maryland fell to the No. 1 Blue Devils, and did not get another chance to dethrone a No. 1 until the ACC Tournament Championship game. In a rematch of the Terps-Heels regular season game, UNC, tabbed No. 1 again, claimed the conference title over the Terps on March 5.
- Maryland is one of just two teams in the country to face the only three teams in the nation to be ranked No. 1 this season. Old Dominion is the only other team to have player the Tar Heels, Blue Devils and Lady Vols this season.

### TERPS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Maryland is 7-4 against teams ranked in the top 25 in the polls at the time of the meeting, the most wins over ranked teams since 1988-89 when it defeated nine ranked opponents. Eight of the 11 games the Terps played this season against ranked teams came against teams rated in the top 10.
- All four of Maryland's losses were to teams ranked No. 1 or No. 2 at the time of the meeting.

### UP NEXT

- Maryland and Utah will be playing for the right to go to the Final Four in Boston. The NCAA semifinals take place on April 2 at the TD Banknorth Garden with the title game played on April 4.
