QUICK HITS

- Maryland is ranked fifth in the final *Associated Press* poll, appearing in the top five every week.
- The Terps' No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament is the second time in the history of the program they have earned a top seed.
- The Terrapins are making their second NCAA Elite Eight appearance in three years and sixth overall in the history of the program.
- Maryland is one win from tying the program record. The Terps won 34 games during their title run in 2006.
- Crystal Langhorne became only the fourth player in ACC history to score 2,200 points and grab 1,200 career rebounds.
- Junior Kristi Toliver needs just seven assists to tie the Maryland career record. She already owns the ACC single-season record.
- Junior Laura Harper needs just one block to tie the senior class school record.
- Maryland surpassed its win total from a year ago. Last year's team went 28-6 overall and 10-4 in ACC play.
- Maryland has recorded four-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in school history.
- For the first time in the history of the program, Maryland has won 10 ACC games in three-consecutive seasons. Its 13 league wins and 92.9 winning percentage both tie school records.
- Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver have been named finalists for the WBCA Wade Trophy.
- The Terps' four All-ACC selections are a school record. Crystal Langhorne is Maryland's first four-time All-ACC honoree and one of just 10 in the history of the ACC to be named to the first team three times.
- Marissa Coleman's three-straight All-ACC selections makes her one of four Terrapins all-time to be named all-conference at least three times.
- The Terps are one of two teams in NCAA history to have four players with 1,300 career points on the roster (along with 01-02 Connecticut). They are one of 12 known teams with four 1,000-point scorers.
- The Terps have had at least one player with a double-double in 29 of their 34 games and lead the country with 46 team double-doubles.
- Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver are finalists for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.
- Kristi Toliver is a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard.

TERPS REACH ELITE EIGHT; FACE NO. 2-SEED STANFORD

- The Terps advance to the regional semifinals for the sixth time in the history of the program and the second time in three years. The top-seeded Terps in the Spokane Regional face No. 2-seeded Stanford on Monday, March 31 at 6:30 p.m. PT/9:30 p.m. ET in the Elite Eight.
- Maryland's last trip to the Elite Eight was in 2006 when they advanced to the Final Four and won the national championship. Six players on that squad are on this season's team who will face the Cardinal on Monday night.
- Maryland's matchup on Monday night will be broadcast on ESPN with Debbie Antonelli and Dave Patsch calling the action. Heather Cox will be on the sidelines.

TERPS APPROACH ANOTHER FIRST

- While Maryland is one of only 12 known teams in NCAA history with four active players with 1,000 points, it is also one of only two with four players with 1,300 points. The Terrapins need just five points to become the only team in NCAA history with four players with 1,400 points.
- Crystal Langhorne has scored over 2,000 points in her career, while Marissa Coleman recently surpassed the 1,500-point mark. Kristi Toliver needs just two points for 1,400 for her career, while Laura Harper needs three. All four Terps are ranked in the top 15 all-time at Maryland in scoring.

- Maryland's Crystal Langhorne and Kristi Toliver are among the 12 finalists selected for the State Farm/WBCA Wade Trophy, presented to the national player of the year. The Two were named WBCA Region II All-Americans,

the third time Langhorne has received the honor and the first time for Toliver. Langhorne is a finalist for the Wade Trophy for the second-straight year.

- The candidates were selected by a vote of the State Farm Wade Trophy Committee, comprised of leading basketball coaches, journalists and basketball administrators. Members of the committee select the winner of the State Farm Wade Trophy from the 10-member Division I State Farm Coaches' All-America Team and will be announced at a press conference during the WBCA National Convention on Saturday, April 5 at 9:45 a.m. in Tampa, Fla.

TERPS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Making its 17th NCAA Tournament appearance overall, the Terrapins advance to the the tournament for the fifth-straight year, the first time since the team made six-consecutive trips to the Big Dance from 1988-1993.
- The Terrapins have posted a 24-15 record in 17 appearances, winning the National Championship in 2006 as the No. 2 seed in the Albuquerque Region. They advanced to the second round for the fifth-straight year, a first in the history of the program.
- Maryland's only appearance in the national championship game came in 2006. The Terps have advanced to the Final Four three times in the history of the program (1982, 1989, 2006). They have also been to the Elite Eight six times and the Sweet Sixteen seven times (including the team's trip to Spokane).
- In 1989, Maryland earned the program's first No. 1 seed. It has been the No. 2 seed six times, including the last two seasons. Maryland was also the third seed once in 1983 and has never been the numbers four, five, 10 or 11 seed.
- In its four NCAA Tournament appearances under head coach Brenda Frese, Maryland improved its seeding from a No. 12 in 2003-04, to a No. 7 in 2004-05, to a No. 2 seed in 2005-06 and 2006-07. The Terps earned their first No. 1 seed under Frese this season and their first since 1989.

TOURNAMENT TESTED

- Entering the NCAA Tournament, the Terps boasted plenty of post-season experience. Four starters from this year's team started in the 2006 National Championship game.
- Six of the players have played in at least 11 tournament games. Senior Crystal Langhorne has started a school-record 13 NCAA Tournament games over her career.
- Langhorne and classmate Ashleigh Newman have played in all 13 NCAA Tournament games of their careers, tying the record held by former Terrapin Shay Doron. Senior Jade Perry has played in 12 games, which ties for the fourth-most among all-time Terrapins, while juniors Marissa Coleman and Kristi Toliver have played in 11 tournament games, tying for the sixth-most appearances in school history.

TERPS VS. THE FIELD

- Maryland is 16-3 versus the field of 64, facing 16 teams who earned NCAA tournament bids, postseason victories over Coppin State, Nebraska and Vanderbilt.
- The Terps picked up a pair of wins each against NCAA Tournament squads Duke and Virginia. Maryland also defeated LSU, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Florida State, Georgia Tech, UC Santa Barbara, Ohio State, Oklahoma and Temple during the regular season.
- Maryland's only three losses of the season came against the New Orleans Region top seed, North Carolina, the No. 2 seed in the Greensboro Region, Rutgers, and Duke, who is the third seed in the Oklahoma City Regional.

TERPS LEAD THE NATION IN DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Maryland's 47 team double-doubles are the most for any team in the nation this season. At least one Terp has achieved the feat in 30 of the team's 35 games. Five different Terrapins

have recorded a double-double this season.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

- In 36 games this season, the Terps have recorded 47 double-doubles and at least one double-double has been posted in all but five games.
- National Player of the Year candidate Crystal Langhorne has recorded a team-leading 15 double-doubles this season. She recorded her 50th-career double-double in the win at Boston College. Thirteen of those double-doubles have come in the last 20 games, including double-doubles in both games of the NCAA Tournament. Harper has 12, her latest coming against Duke in the ACC semifinals.
- Junior Marissa Coleman is third on the team with 10 double-doubles so far, most recently achieving the feat at NC State, Junior Kristi Toliver has accounted for seven double-doubles. She has achieved the feat achieving double figures in points and assists.
- Senior Jade Perry recorded double-doubles three times, as well, reaching double digits in points and rebounds.

CHARITY POINTS

- Maryland has been an offensive machine over the last few years, but it does not just come from layups, jump shots or three pointers. The Terps are also getting some freebees from the free throw stripe, averaging 10.6 more points per game than their opponents from the line (19.0 ppg vs. 8.4 ppg).
- Maryland is shooting a league-best 74.9 percent from the free throw line.

DRAINING THREES

- Maryland has made at least a three pointer in 122-consecutive games. The streak dates back to Jan. 29, 2005 at Arizona.

LANGHORNE IS RIGHT ON

- Two-time All-American Crystal Langhorne is having another solid season from the floor, currently ranked second in the nation in field goal percentage (as of March 16).
- Langhorne has been in the top five in field goal shooting since qualifying for the statistical minimums after the North Carolina game on Jan. 26 and has made 64.6 percent of her shots from the floor.
- Langhorne boasts a 65.2 percent career shooting percentage, which is an ACC record and ranks among the top 15 all-time in NCAA history across all divisions and is in the top five in NCAA Division I history.

BOARDING SCHOOL

- Maryland, the leading rebounding team in the nation the last two years, has shown that controlling the glass can affect the outcomes of games. The Terps are 113-9 when outrebounding opponents since 2004-05 and 6-14 when they collect the same or fewer cars than their opponents.
- The Terps have outrebounded their opponents in 31 games this season, coming out even against Ohio State and Rutgers. Maryland was outrebounded for the first time since last year's ACC Tournament semifinals in the win over Middle Tennessee State and then again at North Carolina.

TOLIVER MOVES INTO 2ND ON MD'S ASSIST LIST

- A finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard, junior Kristi Toliver has become an even stronger floor general.
- Spending part of her summer at Point Guard College refining her skills, Toliver dished out 10 assists against Miami, moving into second all-time at Maryland. She became only the fourth player in the history of the program and 26th in the history of the ACC to dish 500 helpers. Her 576 helpers rank in the top 10 in the league all-time.

BALANCING ACT

- Once again, Maryland is getting all the players involved when it comes to offense. With four players averaging double figures, the scoring is coming from all positions on the court.
- While six different players have led the team in scoring, to date, the Terps have had at least four players score in double figures in 23 games. At least three have reached double figures in every game.
- In the blowout win over Loyola, six Terps scored in double figures that evening. All five scorers reached double digits in the win over UMBC and five players reached double digits in the win over Florida State on Senior Day.

COMING UP

- The winners of the four regional sites move on to the NCAA Final Four in Tampa, Fla. The national semifinals is slated for Sunday, April 6, and the national champion is crowned on Tuesday, April 8.
- The games will be televised nationally on ESPN and ESPN2.
