**Sophomore • 5-9 • Guard**  
**Great Neck, N.Y./Christ the King**

- Kodak/WBCA Region II All-American, the first Terp to earn the honor since 1993 and just the ninth overall.
- One of 30 Midseason Naismith Player of the Year candidates.
- First team All-ACC, the first Terrapin in 11 years to be named to the first team.
- Earned a spot on the ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic first team All-District 2 squad.
- Preseason honors include Naismith Player of the Year watchlist, *Street & Smith's* Honorable Mention All-American and Preseason All-ACC.
- Currently holds Maryland's all-time sophomore class record with 527 points, which is also the seventh-most single-season scoring output in school history.
- Broke the single-season Maryland free throw record which she set last season and has also attempted the fourth-most free throws in a season in school history.
- Named ACC Player of the Week after netting 37 points (Comcast Center record) in the upset of then-No. 5/4 North Carolina (ACC Champions), then scored a school record-tying 39 at Florida State just five days later.
- Was 8-of-15 and 20-for-22 from the free throw line in the 37-point outing vs. the Tar Heels, while adding seven rebounds and five steals.
- In the career record books, ranks seventh in free throws (274), 12th in free throw attempts (349), seventh in three pointers (62) and sixth in 3-point attempts (202). Currently boasts the second-best career free throw percentage in school history.
- Averaged 34.7 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 4.7 apg over a three-game span from Jan. 9-16, posting 37 points vs. UNC, 28 at Georgia Tech and 39 at Florida State.
- Named to Terrapin Classic All-Tournament team after scoring 18 points with four rebounds and four assists vs. UMass and tallying 26 points on 9-for-17 shooting against Marshall.
- Posted fourth 20-point game of the season and had a career-high seven steals (six in the first half) in the home win vs. Monmouth.
- 26 points and eight rebounds in the team's overtime victory at Arizona.
- Has posted double-digit outings 25 times this season, including 12 20-point outings, tied for second most in the ACC and two 30-point games, also the second most in the conference.
- Averaged 19.8 ppg (3rd) in conference games, 5.2 rpg, 3.0 apg, .446 from the field and .800 from the free throw line (9th).
