

2008 EAGL REVIEW

The West Virginia gymnastics team won the 13th annual East Atlantic Gymnastics League (EAGL) Championship on Saturday, March 29, with a season-high score of 196.050 at its own Cary Gymnasium in Morgantown, W. Va. The title marked the sixth all-time for the Mountaineers and the team's first since hosting the event in 2004.

West Virginia beat out reigning 2007 EAGL champ NC State (195.475), who claimed the league's regular season title. The Wolfpack were followed by New Hampshire (194.550), North Carolina (193.950) and Maryland (193.375), which finished fifth. Behind one of their best all-around performances of the season, the Terps bested Pittsburgh (193.175), George Washington (192.975) and Rutgers (189.025).

2008 EAGL Gymnast of the Year Christine Nguyen of North Carolina claimed the all-around title with a score of 39.475, taking first place in the vault and earning first team All-EAGL honors in all four events.

West Virginia senior Meghan Morris finished second in the all-around competition on the strength of her first place performance in the uneven bars (9.850) and floor exercise (9.950). Pittsburgh junior Anya Chayka rounded out the individual champions with a score of 9.850 on the beam.

NC State's Leigha Hancock earned Senior Gymnast of the Year honors while teammate Brittney Hardiman claimed Rookie of the Year accolades.

The 2008 EAGL MVP winners were Nguyen, Hancock, Amy Bieski (West Virginia), Helena Diodati (New Hampshire), Brandi George (Maryland), Alix Croop (Pittsburgh), Leslie Delima (George Washington) and Laura Sevarino (Rutgers).

2008 SEASON RECAP

YOUNG SQUAD PROVIDES REASONS FOR OPTIMISM FOR 2009

The 2008 Maryland gymnastics team began the season with a young, sophomore-laden squad that developed steadily throughout the campaign, peaking at the right time to post many of its top team and individual scores near the season's end.

Led by a quartet of sophomore regional qualifiers in Michele Brenner, Allie Dama, Brandi George and Talia Tossone, the Terrapins were at their best during the month of March. The team notched its season-high total score of 194.250 during its March 15th quad meet against Michigan, Pittsburgh and Temple, as Dama and George fueled a season-best 48.925 team score on the bars.

That performance preceded a team season-high score of 48.700 on the beam during the regular-season finale meet on March 21 thanks in large part to the efforts of George and Tossone.

Virtually the entire team turned in strong performances the following week during 2008 Eastern Atlantic Gymnastics League (EAGL) Championships en route to a fifth-place team finish. During that meet in Morgantown, W.Va., the Terps managed team season-highs in both the vault (48.775) and floor exercise (49.000), tying for the team's best finish since 2004.

Two weeks later Brenner, Dama, George and Tossone represented Maryland at the NCAA Southeast Regional Championships in Gainesville, Fla., hitting seven-for-seven on routines.

But the Terps' late-season success did not come without a tremendous amount of hard work throughout the 2008 campaign, the 30th season under head coach Bob Nelligan.

The Terps opened the season by playing host to Ohio State and West Virginia in consecutive dual meets, narrowly falling to the Mountaineers, one of the top teams in the EAGL. A second-place finish in a quad meet at Texas Woman's on Jan. 27 saw senior captain Gretchen Kittelberger earn a season-best score on the beam (9.700) and freshman Abbey Adams do likewise in the floor exercise (9.825) in just her third collegiate meet.

In a battle for state bragging rights, Maryland knocked off host Towson in the four-team Governor's Cup on Feb. 1, as freshman Kaitlin Joseph scored her season-best mark in the floor exercise (9.750). The Terps' team score of 192.925 the following week during a dual meet at Michigan State marked the team's best overall performance from the season's opening two months.

League play kicked into full gear when Maryland played host to George Washington before defeating New Hampshire in a dual meet on Feb. 24. George enjoyed the team's best individual all-around score of the season (39.275) against the Wildcats, and Tossone tallied a season-best 9.900 in the floor exercise during the same meet.

March commenced with a quad meet at EAGL foe North Carolina during which both of Maryland's senior notched impressive performances for the injury-plagued squad. Kittelberger had a season-high score in the vault (9.825), and fellow senior Lindsey Bonomo did likewise in both the vault and the beam.



ALLIE DAMA

A quad meet at George Washington on March 9 preceded the three-meet stretch from March 15 to March 29 during which Maryland produced its team season-high score in every event. During that streak, eight different gymnasts (Adams, Brenner, Dama, George, Kittelberger, Tossone, Margaux Meeks and Lisa Reifschneider) accounted for at least one individual season-best score.

Maryland saved it best for last, as Adams, George, Kittelberger and Tossone each notched at least one individual season-high mark during the EAGL Championships on March 29. The total team performance enabled the Terps to avenge a regular-season loss to George Washington while turning in their second-best total team score of the season (193.375). George's vault score of 9.850 at the league meet tied for the 15th-best individual mark in school history.

Although Maryland did not qualify as a team for the NCAA regionals, Brenner (floor exercise), Dama (uneven bars), George (all-around) and Tossone (balance beam) each punched their tickets by virtue of their strong individual performances. It marked the second consecutive trip to regionals for George and Tossone, while Brenner and Dama qualified for the first time.

Several Terps garnered postseason accolades. Kittelberger claimed one of the EAGL's four yearly awards when she was named 2008 Scholar-Athlete of the Year one season after she received the same honor. The senior later earned Academic All-America and COSIDA Academic All-District honors as well.

Four Maryland gymnasts earned All-EAGL honors led by George, who was named to the first team for all-around and balance beam, as well as the second team for vault, uneven bars and floor exercise.

Brenner (floor exercise), Dama (uneven bars) and Tossone (balance beam) also were named first team all-league honorees at the EAGL awards banquet following the end of the 2008 regular season.




