

MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 13, 2015 ATHLETIC COUNCIL MEETING

I. CHAIR REPORT

- A. Academic Reviews. Dr. Hadley explained the academic review process and reported that track and field/cross country, gymnastics, women's lacrosse, and wrestling were reviewed last year. All teams are performing well academically. Academic reviews this academic year will be conducted in men's basketball, women's basketball, football and softball as approved at the September Council meeting.
- B. Big Ten Conference Meeting. Dr. Hadley shared that the Big Ten Joint Group had discussed several NCAA legislative proposals that seek to address student-athlete time demands. He also noted that the faculty athletics representatives discussed graduate transfers within the Conference but decided not to take any action at this time.

II. DIRECTOR REPORT

Football Update. Kevin Anderson informed the Athletic Council that Randy Edsall was relieved of his duties on Sunday, October 11. Offensive coordinator Mike Locksley will assume the head coaching duties on an interim basis and for the remainder of the football season.

III. UNIVERSITY SENATE PROPOSAL REVIEW

It was agreed to refer the proposal sent to the Athletic Council by the University Senate to the Athletic Council Student Life Committee for initial review. The proposal seeks to repeal the Student-Athlete Handbook social media guidelines.
