I. CHAIR REPORT

- A. ACC Meetings update. Dr. Hadley noted that he recently returned from ACC meetings where there are continued discussions on the integration of Pittsburgh, Syracuse and Notre Dame. He announced that Notre Dame Football student athletes will be eligible for ACC post-graduate scholarships.
- B. Individual Admit Policy. Dr. Hadley informed the council that the academic committee is working with department administrators to look at a revision of the Individual Admit Policy.
- C. NCAA Championships – New Jersey Dr. Hadley noted that the NCAA has pulled several pre-determined NCAA Championships from the state of New Jersey due to the implementation of sports wagering within the state.

II. DIRECTOR REPORT

- A. Competitive Update. Kevin Anderson updated the council on the good starts that Football, Men's Soccer, Women's Soccer, Field Hockey, Cross Country, Men's Golf, Women's Golf and Volleyball were having this year.
- B. ACC Bowl Affiliations. Kevin Anderson shared with the council the bowl affiliations for the ACC and described the selection process.
- C. Future ACC Scheduling. Kevin Anderson informed the council that at the recent ACC meetings future scheduling formats were approved. In football, teams will play eight conference games. In men's and women's basketball 18 conference games will be played with two partners that you play home and away every year. Maryland's partners are Pittsburgh and Virginia.
- D. M Club Hall of Fame Banquet. Kevin Anderson announced the recent inductees into the athletics Hall of Fame and publicly thanked them for their contributions.
- E. Miller Coors/TSM Sponsorship. Kevin Anderson informed the council that Miller Coors has recently begun running ads on the Terrapin Sports Network as they are contractually able to do.



III. ADMISSIONS REPORT

Barbara Gill, Director of Undergraduate Admissions, and Britt Reynolds, Associate Director of Undergraduate Admissions, provided an overview of the admissions process for student athletes to the Council. They reviewed the six most recent freshman cohorts, including general student data and student-athlete data, and commented on the excellent working relationship between the admissions office and ICA.

IV. APR UPDATE

Chris Uchacz, Associate Athletic Director – ASCDU, updated the council on the APR process and how data is submitted to the NCAA. Recently the data for the university was submitted to the NCAA and is now being reviewed.

V. POLICY ON HONORING JERSEYS

Kevin Anderson informed the council of concerns a member of the Board of Regents had about the current Athletic Council policy on honoring jerseys. Specific concerns centered on the academic component. After discussion it was determined that an ad hoc committee would be formed to review the current policy.
