• Three Big Ten schools remain undefeated in conference play as Michigan State and Minnesota are 3-0 and Ohio State is 2-0. At 3-0, the Gophers are off to their best start in Big Ten play since 1990. Minnesota will look for its first 4-0 start in conference play since 1967. The Spartans and Buckeyes both went 8-0 in Big Ten games last season.

• Ohio State and Michigan State each extended double-digit conference winning streaks with victories on Saturday. The Buckeyes claimed their 18th consecutive win in Big Ten play, moving into third place in the conference record book and just two wins away from the record of 20 straight set by Ohio State from 2005-07. Meanwhile, the Spartans won their 12th consecutive conference contest, marking the second-longest Big Ten winning streak in school history and longest since a 16-game streak from 1965-67.

• With their sixth victories of the season last weekend, Michigan State, Minnesota and Nebraska all secured bowl eligibility. Four additional teams can join that group with one more win as Iowa, Maryland, Ohio State and Rutgers have each posted five victories. This season, the Big Ten will feature the largest and most diverse postseason lineup in conference history. See page 4 for 2014-15 Big Ten bowl destinations.

• Ohio State freshman J.T. Barrett ranks among the top 10 players nationally in a wide range of statistical categories. Barrett is third in passing efficiency (182.1), fifth in yards per attempt (9.85), sixth in passing touchdowns (20) and 10th in total offensive yards per game (333.0).

• Big Ten backfields feature four of the top five rushers in the nation in average yards per game. Wisconsin's Melvin Gordon leads all players with 174.3 yards per contest, followed by Indiana's Tevin Coleman in second with 170.3 yards per game. Nebraska's Ameer Abdullah ranks fourth with an average of 146.3 yards per outing while Minnesota's David Cobb is fifth at 144.7 yards per contest.

• With 174 all-purpose yards on Saturday, Nebraska running back Ameer Abdullah climbed two spots into fourth place on the conference's career all-purpose yards list with 6,263 yards. Abdullah, who leads the nation this season with 192.7 all-purpose yards per game, is 203 yards behind Indiana's Anthony Thompson for third place on the conference's all-time list.

• Big Ten teams compete for 16 different rivalry trophies and another one will be up for grabs this weekend. Saturday's Michigan-Michigan State contest features the battle of the Paul Bunyan Trophy. It is the 62nd time the teams will meet with the traveling keepsake on the line.

BIG TEN FOOTBALL AWARDS

The Big Ten will continue to honor its past while recognizing its current standouts at the conclusion of the 2014 campaign. The Big Ten's enhanced football awards program presents 18 individual trophies in addition to the Big Ten Championship trophy, bearing the names of one or two former standouts. The distinguished names on these football awards honor just a small sampling of the countless student-athletes and coaches who have contributed to the conference's rich and storied history.

Seventeen of the honors will be awarded immediately following the regular season, including awards for the best quarterback, running back, receiver, tight end, offensive lineman, defensive lineman, linebacker, defensive back, kicker and punter. Each of these individual position awards features the names of two former student-athletes.

The Big Ten will also continue to honor the conference's top coaches, offensive and defensive players and linemen and freshmen with end-of-year trophies. Big Ten coaches have the opportunity to claim two awards. Media voters will select the Dave McClain Coach of the Year, which has been awarded since 1972, while coaches vote for the Hayes-Schembechler Coach of the Year award. The top offensive player will receive the Graham-George Offensive Player of the Year award, the best defensive player will be awarded the Nagurski-Woodson Defensive Player of the Year award and the best first-year standout will receive the Thompson-Randle El Freshman of the Year award.

The winner of the Big Ten Football Championship Game will receive the Amos Alonzo Stagg Championship Trophy, while the most outstanding player in the game will be awarded the Grange-Griffin Championship Game MVP award. The conference also created two postcollegiate awards - the Ford-Kinnick Leadership Award and the Dungy-Thompson Humanitarian Award.

BIG TEN FOOTBALL DIVISIONAL TIEBREAKER

The Big Ten football championship will be decided by a game played between the two division champions. A team or teams that are not eligible to participate in a postseason football bowl game as a result of NCAA and/or Big Ten sanctions shall not be eligible to participate in the Big Ten Football Championship Game. The winner of the Big Ten Football Championship Game will represent the conference in one of the bowls that comprise the College Football Playoff - the Cotton, Fiesta, Peach, Orange, Rose or Sugar Bowl. If the Big Ten Champion is ranked No. 1, 2, 3 or 4 in the final College Football Playoff poll, the team will play in a semifinal game. Otherwise, the Big Ten Champion will play in the Rose Bowl Game (when not hosting a semifinal) or the Cotton, Fiesta or Peach Bowl.

The following procedure will determine the representative from each division in the event of a tie:

- (a) If two teams are tied, the winner of the game between the two tied teams shall be the representative.
- (b) If three or more teams are tied, steps 1 through 7 will be followed until a determination is made. If only two teams remain tied after any step, the winner of the game between the two tied teams shall be the representative.
 1. The records of the three tied teams will be compared against each other.
 2. The records of the three tied teams will be compared within their division.
 3. The records of the three teams will be compared against the next highest placed teams in their division in order of finish (4, 5, and 6).
 4. The records of the three teams will be compared against all common conference opponents.
 5. The highest ranked team in the first College Football Playoff poll following the completion of Big Ten regular season conference play shall be the representative in the Big Ten Championship Game, unless the two highest ranked tied teams are ranked within one spot of each other in the College Football Playoff poll. In this case, the head-to-head results of the top two ranked tied teams shall determine the representative in the Big Ten Championship Game.
 6. The team with the best overall winning percentage [excluding exempted games] shall be the representative.
 7. The representative will be chosen by random draw.

If one or both of the Big Ten division champions is ineligible to play in the Big Ten Championship Game, then the participant(s) in the Big Ten Championship Game shall be determined by the following procedure:

- a) If the ineligible team is tied for the division championship, then the team it tied with shall be the Big Ten Championship Game representative.
- b) If two or more teams are tied with an ineligible team for the division championship, then the ineligible team is removed and the remaining teams revert to the tie-break procedure.
- c) The division runner-up shall be the Big Ten Championship Game representative.
- d) If there is a division runner-up tie, then the tied teams shall revert to the tie-break procedure.

If the championship game cannot be played (due to any reason beyond the control of the Big Ten Conference), the two division champions (using divisional tie-breakers as set forth above) shall be declared co-champions and the following procedure will be used to determine the Big Ten Conference representative to the College Football Playoff:

- a) Teams ranked No. 1, 2, 3 or 4 in the final College Football Playoff poll will automatically be placed in the College Football Playoff.
- b) If the two divisional representatives met previously in the season and neither is ranked No. 1, 2, 3 or 4 in the final College Football Playoff poll, the team ranked highest in the final poll shall be the representative to the College Football Playoff, unless the other team is ranked within five or fewer places of the higher ranked team. In this case, the head-to-head results of the two teams shall determine the conference's representative.
- c) If the two divisional representatives did not meet previously during the season, the team ranked highest in the College Football Playoff poll shall be the representative.
- d) If the two teams are tied in the College Football Playoff poll, the team with the best overall Big Ten record shall be the representative.
- e) If the two teams remain tied after d), the team with the best combined record of the tied teams against all common Big Ten opponents each team played that season shall be the representative.
- f) If the two teams remain tied after e), the representative will be the team with the best overall winning percentage.
- g) If the two teams remain tied after f), the representative will be the team furthest removed from College Football Playoff, Bowl Championships Series or Rose Bowl Game participation (as appropriate).
- h) If the two teams remain tied after g), the representative shall be determined by a random draw.
